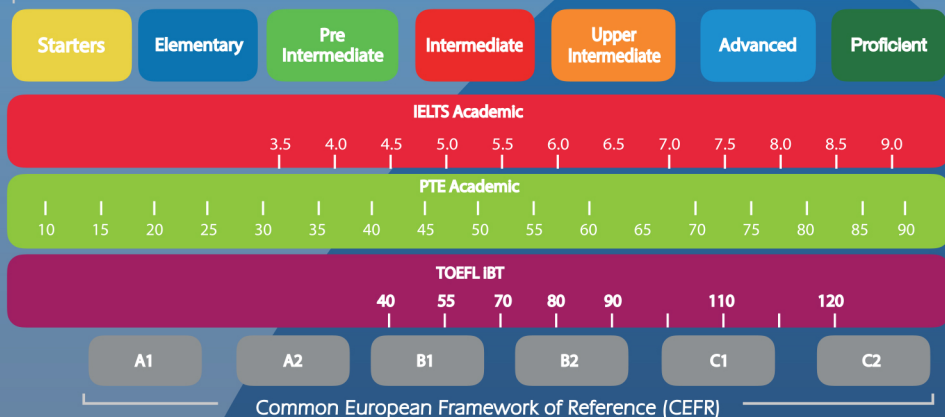

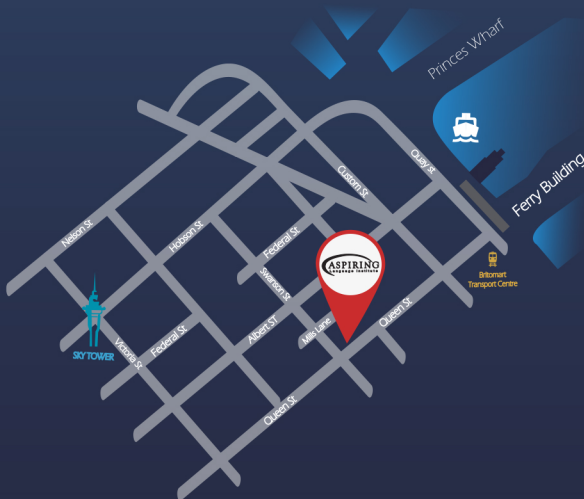
Eligibility for Health Services
